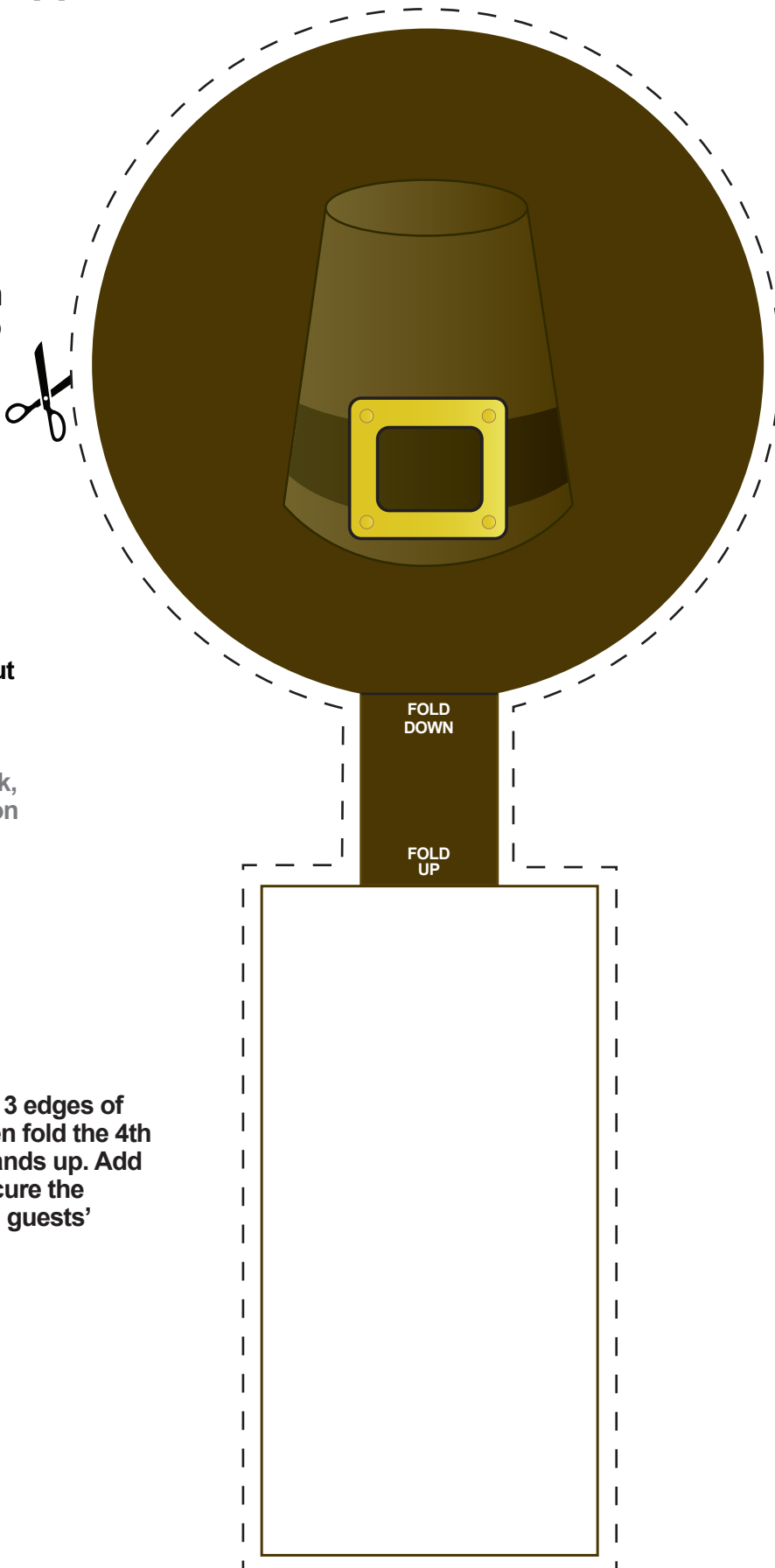
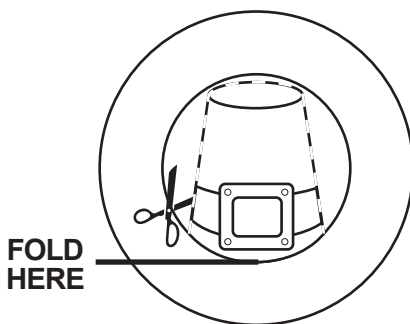

First write in your menu. Then cut along the dotted line. Fold twice where indicated.

TIP: For a more professional look, type your menu out and print it on white stickers that are the same size as the space to the right.

With a razor blade, cut along the 3 edges of the hat. (see below diagram) Then fold the 4th side so that the top of the hat stands up. Add a piece of tape to the back to secure the folded menu. Then place in each guests' water glass.





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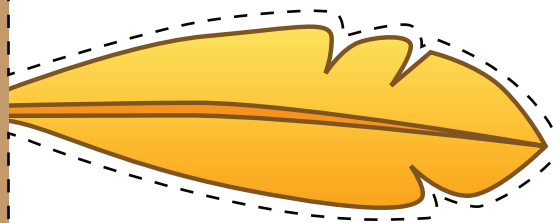

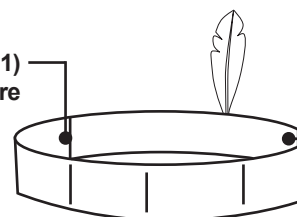
First write in your menu on the bottom strip. Use the vertical lines to separate appetizers, entrees and desserts. Then cut along the dotted line. **TIP:** For a more professional look, type your menu out and print it on white stickers that are the same size as the spaces below.

Nest the two strips inside each other so that the feather is in the back and the lines are in the front. (see diagram at right) You should see both brown sides facing you. Tape the strips together on 1 side. (fig. 1) Fit the ring around the top of your guest's water glass and secure the other side with a second piece of tape. (fig. 2)
